## The Nannette & Walter A. Ramsey Scholarship

The late Walter Ramsey, a long-time resident in the Shelby County community, provided in his Last Will and Testament that a scholarship fund be established to offer the opportunity for financial assistance for graduates of all Shelby County Secondary Schools who intend to further their education.

#### Criteria

- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university, including graduate school.
- Applicants must be a graduate of a Shelby County high school. Okaw Valley High School graduates who reside in Shelby County are eligible.
- The award of the scholarships, as specified by the donors, shall be based upon the applicant's economic need, academic standing, character, integrity, and aptitude for scholastic achievement, as well as the promise of making a worthwhile contribution to society.
- Recipients, upon annual re-application, may be eligible to receive the scholarship for a total of four years. However, the reapplication process only allows that the recipient be given equal consideration among other applicants and does not automatically guarantee a scholarship.

# The Beulah Knecht Scholarship

The late Miss Beulah Knecht, a schoolteacher in the Shelbyville community for many years, provided in her Last Will and Testament that a scholarship fund be established to offer financial assistance for graduates of Shelbyville High School who intend to further their education.

#### Criteria

- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university, including graduate school.
- Applicants must be a graduate of Shelbyville high school.
- The award of the scholarships, as specified by the donors, shall be based upon the applicant's economic need, academic standing, character, integrity, and aptitude for scholastic achievement.
- Recipients, upon annual re-application, may be eligible to receive the scholarship for a total of four years. However, the reapplication process only allows that the recipient be given equal consideration among other applicants and does not automatically guarantee a scholarship.

### **Instructions to Apply for both scholarships:**

- Application must be 100% completed. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- A <u>letter of recommendation</u> must be included from a member of the school faculty or administration. High school seniors and college freshman can submit a letter of recommendation from their High School. College sophomores, juniors & seniors should submit a letter of recommendation from their college or university. The letter should be signed by the instructor or faculty member and printed on the educational institution's letterhead.
- A typed response to the essay question must be included on a separate page.
- A **transcript** from your current school must be included.
- If you are eligible for both the Nannette & Walter Ramsey and the Beulah Knecht scholarship, please complete just one application. Your application will be considered for both scholarships.
- Application must be postmarked by March 15, 2025.
